All funds raised will help to meet the £5 million it costs to run the hospice services each year. Less than 20% of this comes from the government, for the rest we are dependent on the goodwill of our local community and supporters:

- ♥ **£2** could go towards funding appropriate toys and books for a bereaved child;
- ♥ **£5** could fund 2 delicious and nutritious smoothies, which can encourage a patient with a poor appetite to enjoy eating again;
- ♥ **£10** could go towards enabling a patient take part in a creative activity session to aid relaxation;
- ♥ **£17** could fund ice cream for all the patients in our Hospice beds for a week (ice cream is easy to digest and a popular dessert);
- ♥ **£20** could fund one of our Hospice beds for an hour;
- ♥ **£25** could go towards funding support for a child who has lost a loved one;
- ♥ **£30** could fund a support session from our incredible therapy team in our Spring Centre health and wellbeing hub;
- ♥ **£50** could fund a welcome Hospice community nurse visit to a patient living at home.

All our services are provided free of charge to patients and their family and friends to ensure full support and care when time is precious.
